

OUR FOCUS

Prevention

We provide various strategies to ensure the people we serve do not fall into the cycle of housing instability that can devastate families and alter the course of children's lives. These include administering a Homelessness Prevention Program and FEMA emergency food and shelter program, providing rental assistance, landlord mediation, and developing community-based approaches that keep families housed.

Stabilization

Homelessness has many causes, and housing stability requires multiple solutions. We operate programs that address most aspects of stabilization, including services with our re-housing programs. We create the basis for security and stability that separates families and individuals from poverty and allows them and their children to aspire to the future every individual and child deserves.

Rapid Resolution

Beginning in 2021, we started a housing intervention program designed to prevent immediate entry into homelessness or to immediately resolve a household's homelessness once they enter shelter or an unsheltered situation. Rapid Resolution is a VA model and includes both Diversion and Rapid Exit strategies with the aim of ensuring homelessness is avoided or as brief as possible when it does occur.

Awareness & Advocacy

We are committed to leading the fight against homelessness by raising awareness of the issue and mobilizing communities to address the root cause of family homelessness. Nationally, 200,000 volunteers are the heart of all we do, providing hospitality, mentorship and most importantly, community.

THE PROBLEM

43% of American households are financially vulnerable and at risk for homelessness.

When people think of homelessness, they don't think of families. But 1/3 of all those without homes are parents with children.

Children experiencing homelessness are 8x more likely to repeat grades, are 3x more likely to be placed in special education programs and are 7x more likely to attempt suicide.

THE SOLUTION

- ✓ Family Promise delivers life-saving services at 1/3 the cost of traditional shelters.
- ✓ FPWC has served 1,350 individuals and avoided/shortened 500 episodes of homelessness.
- ✓ 81% of the families we've serviced have found housing, disrupting the cycle of homelessness in our community.
